





You'll experience romance you've never known before

Like in a large bird's nest overlooking the forest and into the distance beyond with a glass of wine. This could be your perfect weekend at **DUBoDOM**. In the crown of a large oak tree, above the **Svätý Jur vineyards**, it's a unique joint creation by architect Pavel Šiška and winemaker Michal Bažalík. An unobtrusive dark exterior in a 'clean' design, brightened from the inside with massive branches running across the interior. Offering privacy for four, it has full amenities, a sauna and a grand terrace perfect for wine tasting. During the summer you can even swim in the wooden barn. The Tree House will be your fantastic escape from the hustle and bustle of the city, but not far from interesting places in and around Svätý Jur. If you prefer to explore by bike, take advantage of the new **Small Carpathian-Šúr cycling route Jurava**



secrets of ancient houses

You can return to civilisation quickly and get to know Svätý Jur, rich in history and precious architecture. Take a walk through the **Town Conservation Reservation** and take advantage of **Martina Klúčiková's perfect guide service**, she will take you along the picturesque secret streets and draw you into the town's stories. According to Martina, the greatest gem is the Gothic **Church of St. George with a very rare altar**, this church is visited by people from all over the world. The **cemetery** itself hides four cultural monuments and rare gravestones. If you're here in July, enjoy Friday evening in the 17th century **Renaissance House**, which hasn't lost any of its charm, as the owners are able to preserve it in its original form and organise interesting events in it.



ancient estates and wild wetlands

When walking through historic Svätý Jur, take a break in the garden of nobleman and painter Frederick Karl von Scheidlin, the so-called **Scheidlin's Garden**; there are also many children's activities. When you have the power and desire to go into nature, there are several possibilities nearby. **Jurský Šúr**, an area of wetlands and groves, is to the south. Take a stroll through the untouched nature along a large pond to the **Pannský Grove**. You can also choose a 4 km **nature trail** through this ten thousand year' old unique nature reserve in Central Europe. The **Great Moravian fortified settlement of Neštich and the ruins of the Gothic castle Biely Kameň (White Stone)** are on the opposite side, in the woods above the terraced vineyards.





wine tradition and glass beauty

If you'd like to experience wine-growing traditions and also want to **experience tasting in the dark**, for example, go to neighbouring **Pezinok**. There you'll the largest collection of ancient grape presses in the **Small Carpathian Museum**, you could also see the current exhibition and they organise non-traditional tasting of excellent wines from the region to order. The **Town Museum** is just opposite, and will present you with a permanent archaeological attractions exhibition where you can see beautiful **sacral sculptures by a Pezinok ceramist, Jozef Franko**, in the **Ján Kupecký Gallery**, which is part of the Museum. Finally, in the Renaissance chateau transformed into the exclusive **Palace Art Hotel Pezinok**, you can visit the art **glassmakers' gallery and the revitalised Chateau Winery**. You can relax while taking a walk or on a bench in the Chateau Park by the ponds.



or high level


in a beautiful place, there is another place in Pezinok that you should definitely see. The **largest water mill in Slovakia** is hidden in a picturesque courtyard with a small café and an adjacent orchard and has a truly magical atmosphere. The **Schaubmar's Mill belongs to Slovak National Gallery**, and they have managed to interconnect the beautiful rural space perfectly with high cultural and visual arts as well as local community activities. There is a **permanent milling exhibition** demonstrating the development of milling in the Small Carpathian region from the 18th century until the mid-20th century. Exceptional value is added by the varying **thematic exhibitions of the most respected works of contemporary modern art and design with swift curatorial interpretations**. Check out the mill programme before the weekend, you may be able to visit some of the attractive events. They organise great workshops, creative family workshops or summer camps.






picturesque land areas and an exotic farm

Enjoy the **nature trails** on foot or by bike. Start in the **historic centre of Svätý Jur** – from the horse-drawn railway station, through Pustáky and Gaštanica to the fortified settlement with massive ramparts – the trail has 17 stops. The **wine-growing nature trail in Pezinok** has 12 stops and will reveal the oldest vineyards on the Stará hora (hill) slopes, lined with long strips of bulk stones. From a distance you can see a special rocker well and a **small exhibition Stone and Wine from the Small Carpathian Mountains Geopark** is part of the trail. Our **Small Carpathians Travel Guide** will also guide you through the trails. You will experience exotic animal diversity while visiting **Ali Farm** in nearby **Vinosady**. The family that owns the farm will introduce you to the secrets of beekeeping and you can walk through the **Beekeeping Trail** leading through the village and land area.




in the joys of movement

Enjoy nature on horseback in the **Rozálka Equestrian Facility** with a hotel and restaurant, located on the outskirts of Pezinok near vineyards and forests. Next to Rozálka, you'll find the **Pezinok Arena** where you can also enjoy ice skating even during the summer. It has two options for golf lovers. There is a **Golf Range** with 25 tees in **Cajla**, part of Pezinok. There is a wine museum or outdoor art objects at the site. You can also go to **Chorvátsky Grob to get a Čierna Voda**. The **Golf Club Elán**, a nine-hole academic business golf course is in the **Hotel Agatka** courtyard. There is also an equestrian facility next to the hotel.



a yummy crispy and hearty experience!

We recommend the goose feast in the **Slovenský Grob** village as the first gourmet experience. The 100-year old tradition is kept here by the **Geese Roasters Guild**, so go for a fantastic crispy goose with legendary *lokše* (Slovak potato flatbread) right here. Enjoy burgers and classic menus at the **Garage Caffè Bar** and don't miss **Chokokafé in the Renaissance House** with amazing, (also) gluten-free cookies and excellent coffee in **Svätý Jur**. In **Pezinok**, there are more great food options, you'll find **restaurants like Pezinský Preš, Korzo or Lalia** and others, with a rich menu of domestic and international cuisine. Enjoy a cup of coffee and a slice of cake in the **Mlsná Emma Chocolate Factory**, which includes an **Art shop** – a great tip for buying a gift from local artists.




and for wine, in every direction

They're a symbol, pride, livelihood and enjoyment – the Small Carpathian vineyards are full of diverse grape varieties. Thanks to the vine-growers care and the amazing art of wine-making, many of them are world-class. Taste the wine! **Vinocentrum Svätý Jur** is a unique wine shop with a very extensive selection – they have up to 90 wines. Taste and buy local wines from 20 Svätý Jur wineries. Wander into the historic premises of a Piarist monastery, where the purely family **Winery with the Bognár wine shop** has its base. Exceptional wines can also be found in **Slovenský Grob**. In the **Chateau-vin Wine Shop** next to a guest house and restaurant, don't just focus on the popular and most sought after Small Carpathian wines.



toast your health!

Pezinok gained fame and wealth in ancient history thanks to quality wine production. Visit a picturesque winery called **U vínnej mušky ('At the wine fly')** for wine tasting from local winemakers. Matyšák branded wine can be enjoyed in the evening at **Vinum Galeria Bozen**, and the region's best wines can also be bought in **Radničná vinotéka ('Town Hall Wine Shop')** and **Mestská vinotéka ('Town Wine Shop')**. Plan a small turn to **Šenkvice** for excellent wine. Local top winemakers are a credit to the village. Visit the **Repa Winery** family winery shop, which is one of the youngest, but their wine is already known all over Slovakia. A winery where you can relax, for example, on a lookout tower with a panoramic view and a glass of award-winning wine, this is **Karpatská Perla ('Carpathian Pearl')**. The owners will gladly tell you about their vineyards, about their care, and they will guide you through the cellars where can taste their 'pearl' wines in a beautiful space.

and you let yourself be pampered

You don't need to pack much for the chateau as it's renovated and converted into the **Palace Art Hotel Pezinok** and exclusively equipped for your convenience. The newly established **Chateau Winery** is also located in the chateau. A winery museum is located in the magnificent cellars under the chateau, where you can taste the wines under this brand. The chateau also features a boutique hotel, a modern glass gallery, a restaurant, a chateau wine bar and a wellness centre. The chateau is fully accessible and offers organised tours in different languages. Take a pleasant walk on wide paths even with an umbrella in the **English park** with a lake and rare trees, the park was founded in 1844 by Count Pálffy.

If it's not raining, enjoy wandering around the town on an electric bike, the hotel will be happy to rent them to you.



in romantic wellness, in the embrace of the forest

Because the forest is beautiful in almost all weather conditions, you'll experience true relaxation in the comfort of the **Hotel Zochova chata**. This hotel is located in the middle of the Small Carpathian forests in **Modra – Piesok**. It underwent extensive reconstruction and modernisation with regard to the genius loci and the surrounding nature and in accordance with Feng Shui principles in 2007. Thanks to the generous glazing with many wooden elements, you'll feel a closeness to nature and a perfect connection with the dense beech forest that protects your privacy from every room, restaurant or wellness.




with the muses of museums

Start the **'Tour Štúr' in Modra** with a museum for the most outstanding personality of Slovak national life, **Ludovít Štúr**. His iconic marble statue is in the centre and a magnificent **monument, Slovenská Jar ('Slovak Spring') in the historical cemetery**. In the museum you'll see unique personal items not only of Štúr, but also from his colleagues **Hurban** and **Kalinčiak**. The **Ludovít Štúr Museum** often exhibits works of art by Slovak artists and written documents. After visiting the museum, go down to the city through a beautiful linden alley, alongside the two famous churches to a magical **historic cemetery** with rare tombstones. In Modra, you'll also appreciate the craft beauty centred in the **Slovak Ceramic Sculpture Museum**. In the rotunda bastion of the town fortifications at **Ignác Bizmayer Gallery**, being part of the museum, you'll admire the works of this master of figural ceramic creation. **Pezinok** naturally has a number of important museums; you can read about them in the previous weekend tip 'In the house on the tree'.



with a top guide

For interesting historical things, apart from museum visits, it's an excellent and comfortable choice to ask someone who really knows. And we know exactly who to ask! We recommend meeting with **guide Martina Klúčiková**, she will guide you through the Modra paths of **Ludovít Štúr**, even if it's raining. She will tell you many things at the historic cemetery, you'll also experience a **night lantern tour of Modra** and with her, you can arrange a beautiful and unique **walk through historic villas in the ancient resort of Modra – Harmónia**. Martina is also interested in the German forest community – the **Huncokars** who once lived and worked in the Small Carpathian forests. Therefore, you can join her and take a stroll through the nature forest park trails following the **Huncokars' traces**, past the **historic old school** to the **mountain cemetery**.



also on an art tour

The skills of winemakers and the works of artists, this is a perfect harmonic connection, even in bad weather. On the contrary, the rain can give your journey to art in the Small Carpathians the right atmosphere. Go to **Modra – Kráľova**, to **Zoya Museum & Elesko Wine Park**. The wine complex building is minimalist in design with a backdrop of vineyards and nearby forests. Take a walk through the winery's generous art gallery, taste wine in modern wine cellars and dine in a stylish restaurant. You don't have to travel to Bratislava to experience high art. The **Slovak National Gallery** brings contemporary design art gems directly to the periphery of the capital, and you'll feel a strong artistic and cultural impression in **Schaubmar's Mill in Pezinok**. Interesting community events take place there on weekends – the programme is easy to find on their social network. The mill cafe offers wine, cakes and great coffee.



or walks through the Renaissance

If you enjoy London weather in Renaissance streets, don't hesitate to go further to **Svätý Jur**. With our **Small Carpathians Travel Guide app**, you certainly won't get lost as it will gradually guide you through the **Svätý Jur Town Conservation Reservation**. Again, you can also make use of the **guide knowledge of Martina Klúžiková**, for whom Svätý Jur is an emotional affair. You'll discover the horse railway station, the synagogue and the Pálffy Manor House. You'll learn about important personalities from the history and the recent past who lived and worked here and you can take up the opportunity of tasting wine at one of Svätý Jur wineries.




when you can find a castle sanctuary, you won't sleep under a tree

A tour of the vast Renaissance castle **Červený Kameň ('Red Stone')** will give you an insight into the life and housing culture of the aristocracy and bourgeoisie in Slovakia from the Renaissance to the Art Nouveau. Walk through the salons, bedrooms and knight's hall, peek into the huge wine cellars and castle mill. The castle has a sophisticated defence system that you can learn about during a special tour. When the rain stops, enjoy **Falconry Court Astur**, the French park and the surrounding forests. You'll also be guided around the Červený Kameň castle by **Okolohradná potulka ('Round the castle wandering') – a nature trail** leading through an old Jewish cemetery, to a lookout point at Kukla Hill, alongside the Pálffy Chapel to Calvary with a Baroque sculpture, to old mines and then back to the castle..



behind the potter's wheel and behind the crocheted magic

You need a wine jug, so give pottery a go. Enjoy this possibility in the **Majolika R workshop in Pezinok – Grinava**. Creating clay objects will relax you, spinning the potter's wheel is a wonderful experience and an original memory will materialise from it. You also be able to admire the perfect ceramic art of masters during visits to traditional Modra workshops in the **Slovak Folk Majolika**, which has a shop on the square, or in the house with a family workshop called **Keramika Ďureje**. In **Modranska** ceramics, they use the power of traditional pattern fragments and push the overall look of their products into a contemporary design – they'll be happy to see you in their workshop with a shop. There is an elegant lady living in **Modra** who preserves the tradition of another beautiful craft – **bobbin lace**. **Textile artist Darina Lichnerová** is a true **crochet artist** and you can visit her in her private studio. She will show you how she creates her art and what can be decorated with bobbin lace. However, it's necessary to make an appointment in advance.





when your tummy is rumbling

You'll certainly get hungry while travelling for the art and history of the Small Carpathian region, but you can eat at every 'stop'. You just need to know where. Enjoy the morning with homemade spelt cakes in **Bonžúr café** in **Pezinok**. For lunch or dinner, visit one of the local restaurants in Pezinok and Svätý Jur, and have an artistic afternoon snack in the renowned chocolate factories. See! the weekend in the 'House on the tree' or the directory, everything is there! You'll be offered a sandwich breakfast with a cake in pleasant **Café Modur** in **Modra**, and try **Starý dom ('The Old House')** for a big meal or the **restaurant at the Hotel pod Lipou or Biolka in Kráľová**. You can also try a tasty meal in the **Taverna pod Baštou at the Červený Kameň Castle**. How about roast goose!? You'll only experience a true **goose feast in Slovenský Grob**, thanks to the **Geese Roasters Guild**. You won't hear a bad word about this tradition there and Grob is not far away!



also in wine galleries.

With an easy step around the puddles, treat yourself abundantly to a perfect excursion to wine cellars and wine bars in the wide surroundings of your hotel, but strategically. In **Modra**, sit down for a drink or two at the **500-years-old Pivnica U Pradedu wine cellar**, which has an extensive selection of the best Modra wines. Excellent Pezinok wines can be enjoyed in **U vínnej musky**, a small wine bar in **Pezinok**. In **Svätý Jur**, you'll be offered a selection of wines and sparkling wines directly at the **Dubovský & Grančič** winery, or in the beautiful historic premises of the **Bognár Winery with a wine shop**. Visiting **Karpatská Perla winery in Šenkvice** will be a relaxing experience at the covered lookout tower. We believe that the Small Carpathian wines you bring home from the weekend will remind you of these delicious experiences.

in a pleasant environment and a sweet-smelling duvet

You decided to finally experience it, climb the heights, enjoy the speed and maybe saddle a horse. Feel free to do these things, the Small Carpathians are waiting you! But first, find your starting point – accommodation! In the evenings you can talk about the exciting, adventure-packed weekend days in the picturesque setting at **Villa Vinica in Limbach**, or in the **Karolína Guest House in Slovenský Grob** – here they'll also roast fantastic goose for you. There are number of accommodation possibilities in the **centre of Pezinok**, including **Penzion 77 – Garni** with a nice pink garden and there is a hotel with beautiful horses on the outskirts of the town, at **Areál Rozálka**. Directly in **Modra** you can relax in the wellness of **Hotel Majolika**, or in **Hotel Sebastian u Hoffera**. We've mapped all the convenient accommodation, even for the most demanding ones, and you can find all of them on **malekarpaty.travel** – choose and enjoy the ride on the wave of adrenaline!

on a forest trail with the wind through your hair

Do you want to go down the hill on a **Mountain cart**? Riding on a forest trail (2.7 km) will give fun to all members of your weekend party. Those interested can make use of cars from **Rača** (of course, the date must be booked) to get to the start at **Bielý kríž ('White Cross')**. You can then cool down at the **Rača summer swimming pool in Knižkova dolina**. If you like to learn something historical about your current location while doing sports, go to the **14th century Church of St Philip and Jacob**, which is the most important local architectural monument. You can enjoy cycling on **cycle routes** with the wind running through your hair, maps can be found at **malekarpaty.travel** and also the new **Small Carpathian-Šúr cycling route Jurava – www.jurava.sk**.

you no longer have to ask the birds



Do you like heights? In the summer of 2018, the **Alexander Filípek Lookout Tower** grew more than 20 metres on **Veľká Homola** Hill, and its conquest is a compulsory experience for you! It's named after the renowned visionary forest engineer, who was responsible for sophisticated forest management and sensitive cultivating the surrounding forest environment in Modra in the latter half of the 19th century – **Harmónia**, a well-known resort with **beautiful villas** was created. You can get to the lookout tower through a forest park, a walk with a gradual elevation from the Modra part of Piesok, or longer ascending from the **Kučišďorf dam**, around **Horáreň pod Širokým** with views of the town of Pezinok. It's quite possible that you'll see deer here! From the top of the tower you'll also see the distant Alps. Those who like to climb rocks will certainly enjoy the massive and beautiful quartzite formations close to the lookout tower, called **Traja jazdci ('Three Riders')**. You can see a long way from the lookout tower, but the view of Modra is prevented by the surrounding hills. So go to the town and look at the landmark – the **Town Tower**, and enjoy the quaintness.

and you can fly yourself

Do you want to stay in heavenly highs? A runway and adrenaline are waiting for you with the most experienced Slovak pilots. With a **bird's eye** view you'll enjoy the beautiful view of the Small Carpathian foothills and the wide lowland. Červený Kameň Castle, Smolenice Castle, Budmerice Manor House, ruins, peaks and valleys of the Small Carpathians, vast vineyards, picturesque villages and water worlds... you can see and enjoy all this in one flight! It's a must-do experience for all adrenaline connoisseurs. The **Pilot Club** with its base in **Kráľová pri Senci** will provide you with a sightseeing flight and you can choose the route. Your plane will take off from the airport in Dubová or Sládkovičovo. It's necessary to book in advance, and they also offer **balloon flights and flight courses**.

still being and feeling young

There are few places in Slovakia with really professional pump tracks and one of them can be found in the Small Carpathians. **Bike Park Zochova Chata** in the forest above **Modra** provides adrenaline enjoyment on a bike, scooter, skates or skateboard. You'll improve your coordination and fitness. The track's creator is Filip Polc, a Slovak elite mountain bike rider, who also like to visit often and ride. You can try the breathtaking descents from the surrounding hills on a bike, or just cycle along the trails. For example, the Small Carpathian forests are absolutely perfect for nutritious trail runs, just follow the marked hiking trails and enjoy incredible nature transformations. If you want to experience adrenaline in a climbing harness, there's a **rope centre** at **Hotel pod Lipou in Harmónia** – you can discover more about the hotel and its sports and recreation site in our last weekend tip.





with the joy and energy of conquering the mountain

Three of the highest Small Carpathian seven-hundred-metre peaks await action tourists. Views from **Vápenná, Vysoká and Záruby** ridges are truly breathtaking and wonderful looking as a reward, even though the overall ascents aren't so demanding, there are a few more technical sections where your adrenaline level increases a Small. Save your strength on parts of the sections before the summit, when the trail literally bites the hillside and you'll have to cope with steeper ascending and rocky, slippery slopes. And if your children can do it? With the right motivation – you might see deer and mouflons


– and yes, definitely correct footwear!

Those who have the time after climbing the top of the highest Záruby can continue along the ridge to the **Ostrý Kameň ('Sharp Stone')** Castle ruins – a beautiful route to a magical place!



in the footsteps of precious ore or climbing rock

The Small Carpathians have a rich mining history, which is now reminded by the **Mining Trail in Pezinok and Modra Mining Trail**. In the gold footsteps you'll see mining trenches, pass through old quarries, underground mines, mining pits, discover the places of mines, shafts and mining galleries. Outside the mining trail near Modra – Harmónia near the robust **Medvedia skala ('Bear Rock')**, which is also used by climbers for training, there is approximately 400 metres of corridors hollowed deep into the quartzite massif behind the narrow entrance of the gallery called **Bartolomej**. It's the longest exploratory gallery around Modra. Various animals, bats and salamanders live or hibernate there. However, you should know that for protection reasons, Bartolomej isn't yet officially part of the nature trail.



on a horseback, adrenaline in bends

If you're sitting in a **horse saddle** for the first time, you'll also enjoy a pleasant, but small adrenaline rush. You can ride a horse in the enclosure, but also on the surrounding forest trails in **Areál Rozáľka in Pezinok**. You can also enjoy exploring **Jurský Šúr** with its large grove, ponds and wetlands by **riding a horse when visiting the nearby Čierna Voda Equestrian Facility near Chorvátsky Grob**. If you prefer family farms and want to enjoy horseback riding for example to **Červený Kameň Castle**, go to the **Leonard Farm – JK Doľany**, which has its stables at the cooperative site. Horses can also have a different form and for those who feel better behind the wheel than with a bridle in their hands, we have a good adrenaline tip. Close to Doľany, near the village of **Dlhá**, **there is a sports and recreational site Motokáry Dlhá (go-karts)** with top services. They put you in the machine and release you on a truly professional go-kart circuit. In addition to providing a certified quality track and go-karts, after riding there, you can eat and take a shower.



when you become really hungry

During the action weekend, hunger soon catches-up with you, but don't worry! In the Small Carpathians you'll be well fed and you have something to drink at almost every corner. When you're in **Rača**, go to **Račianský dvor** for traditional homemade food or Italian cuisine in **Don Saro Cucina Siciliana**. In **Piesok, Modra** you can refresh yourself in the charming tavern **Furmanská krčma**, which belongs to Hotel Zochova chata, you may want to try something good in the **Bowling Restaurant in Harmónia or in the Biolka in Kráľová**. On your way from the airport in Dubová, you can stop at **Hošťacka viecha** – they have homemade food and desserts, seasonal cheeses and wine produced by themselves. **The B-Club Doľany restaurant** is closest to the go-kart track, it's exceptional for its collection of classic motorcycles. During the weekend you can try many good restaurants and wine bars in Pezinok and directly in Modra and its surroundings, just look into our directory and choose according to your taste.



and finally, taste what the Empress liked.

In **Doľany**, head to the **Vína z Mlyna** family winery. Warning! Their taproom is only open on Fridays and Saturdays throughout the summer, but you have to experience the space, feasting and tasting! Or visit the big **JM Doľany Winery** on the outskirts of the village and taste excellent wine with them. They will guide you through their wine cellars and vineyards. The slopes below the Rača forests are made for cultivating noble vines. The famous Račianska Frankovka (Blaufränkisch) was also recognised by Maria Theresa as wine suitable for the imperial table. You can see the quality wines for yourself in the **Račianska vinotéka** wine shop, which belongs to the local wine association. There are also successful successors in the rich tradition of producing great wines at the **Villa Vino Rača** winery. You'll find the **Michal Sadloň Winery in Limbach**, which has won the MVC Wine Grower of the Year award on several occasions. **The Small Carpathian Wine Route (MVC)** boasts nearly 300 members – not just winemakers and associations whose delicious wines you can taste during the wine events.


tuned in an ideal environment

Spending a relaxing weekend with your children requires at least a grain of ingenuity. We understand you, so we chose a strategic point for you – the modern **Hotel pod Lipou**, which opened its new section with wellness in spring 2019 is not only attractive for children. The hotel has a vast and entertaining compound on the edge of the forest, but is close to the town. It's located in the **recreation area Harmónia near Modra**. Spacious rooms and suites with great facilities await you. The resort features a sports ground with tennis courts, a basketball and football field, petanque fields, a beach volleyball field and children's zones. There is also a generous summer pool with a garden, a pond, a rope centre and a private pottery workshop. The hotel is equipped with **electric bicycle rental** with a charger. For those who admire ancient architecture, we recommend an easy sightseeing tour of magical Harmónia. There are many **poetic historical villas** in this once well-known aristocratic resort.



along a fairy-tale trail to space mysteries

The Forest **Manor Trail** from Harmónia along the red hiking trail has amazing surprises for you. You'll be greeted by tree creatures – fantasy figures made from trees. You'll pass through the woods, over the bridges on the creek, past the gazebos and perhaps you'll also see a black stork nesting there. Or, follow the blue trail to **Zámčisko Hill**, where you'll have a **romantic view of Modra**. Both trails lead to the observatory (the red one directly to it), which you can visit every Sunday. In the **Astronomical and Geophysical Observatory** you'll discover what space observations researchers do here and what instruments they use. In this part of the Small Carpathians you can also explore **Modra's mining trail** and geocaching players can look for hidden boxes.



you can conquer the surrounding hills easily

Do you like climbing the hill and then even higher? If you like, take a walk around **Tis Rocks** to the majestic, brand new **Alexander Filípek Lookout Tower in Veľká Homola**. It's more 20 metres high and you can climb 120 steps. You'll see almost all of the Small Carpathians, but also the far-reaching Alps, lowlands, reservoirs, villages and towns. On the way from the lookout tower, in the Hotel Zochova chata carpark, there is a large wooden playground and **Bike Park – a pumptrack** which you can try at any time. A slightly smaller, but paradoxically a Small more adrenaline **lookout tower stands on Kukla** hill above the village of **Dubová**. You can get up the hill to the Fúgelka Lodge by car and make a tour from one side or the other. Along the way you come across rocky formations called **Čertove zuby** ('Devil's Teeth') and you'll also find a small cave there.



under a gigantic chestnut with a falcon or eagle on your hand


The Pálffy family owned many beautiful manor houses, castles and chateaus in the Small Carpathians. Take a tour of the noble and knight's dwellings. Visit **Červený Kameň Castle** – climb the lookout bastion, explore the moats. Children also like the French garden and immediately mistake it with a small labyrinth. The **Falconry Court Astur**, which is part of the castle grounds, allows you to hold a real predator. They have the largest collection of these birds in Slovakia.

The castle is surrounded by a forest and vineyards under it. There is a giant **500-year-old chestnut tree** growing on the periphery, the largest in the country. It's 23 metres high and has an 8.3 metres girth. How many of you would be needed to hug it together? There is also trail blazing to this rare tree from the centre of Častá village.



outside the walls, in palaces and castle parks

We have one more tree for your attention in **Modra**. Behind the gardens ending with the **ancient town fortifications**, at the Secondary Viniculture and Fruit Growing School, on the terraces of the hills, there are three protected service trees (**Sorbus domestica**). **One of them is world-class!** Experts agreed that with a trunk diameter of 160 cm and aged around 400 years, it's the largest measured on Earth. Noblemen liked to ride in the woods on horseback when hunting, and therefore the most beautiful Renaissance manor house in the area – **Budmerice Manor House, with a large English park**, was created near Lindavský Forest. It's a perfect place for picnics, games and walks. When you head back to the hills of the Small Carpathians to Smolenice, you'll be welcomed from afar by the romantic **Smolenice Castle**, which aesthetically fits perfectly into the forest environment. From its viewing platform in the tower you can see the distant lowland and Záruby, the highest peak in the Small Carpathians. It's open daily during summer and only on Sundays in the spring. Don't forget to go to the **Smolenice cemetery** with a rare Neo-Baroque family tomb of the Pálffy family, who owned the castle.





in the awesome hiding places of bats

The Small Carpathians underground pearl – **Driny Cave** is also located in **Smolenice**. It's the only accessible cave in Western Slovakia. It's unique for its rich decoration of 'jagged' calcareous sinter deposits called elephant ears and also for the large bat colonies, up to 11 species hibernate there. If you're spending the weekend in the Small Carpathians in early spring, don't miss another rarity in the Smolenice Karst. At 9 metres high, the **Hl-bočiansky Waterfall** is the only waterfall in the Small Carpathians. They call it occasional, as it's only possible to see a significant fall of water at certain times of the year. On the way from Smolenice, stop at a striking building that looks like it's made from large **honeycombs**. You'll notice it. They produce and sell **Včelovina (mead made of honey)**, various types of honey, mead, bee beer and brandy there. And you can spend a Small time there on a pleasant adventurous walk through the **beekeeping garden with art and educational exhibits**.





with forest animals also in rural farms

Mouflons, roe deer, deer, wild boars, foxes, grass snakes, salamanders, frogs, herons, falcons, etc., forests and wetlands full of beautiful animals, there are the Small Carpathians and if you're lucky, you may see all these creatures. However, you can safely enjoy the animals at the **Farm Pod Gašťankou in Modra**. It's a picturesque place in the area between vineyards and forest. They have a contact zoo, a playground and a fragrant herb garden, and they also serve great food. In **Vinosady** near Modra, children will see a real camel from the Gobi Desert, llamas and peacocks and other animals – visit **Ali Farm**, they will tell you the bees secrets, and you can walk through the village and the wine-growing area using the **Beekeeping Trail**. Or visit **Margitín dvor** – a family farm with horses between the villages of **Dubová** and **Píla**. You can climb into the saddle and carry you in a buggy.



splashing and jumping until the lifeguard whistles

Spending a hot summer day deep in the shade of the forest with rays of sunlight is a fairy tale. But if you long for water refreshment, pack your towels and head to the reconstructed retro **swimming pool in Modra** with views of the surrounding hills of the Small Carpathians. There is a buffet and a toddler pool and the water in the pool is slightly heated. The swimming pool's atmosphere reminds you a Small of the nostalgia of the Slovak film *The Sun in the Net*. It's great! For a full meal, stop at the nearby **Kinečko Bistro** with a terrace, which is part of the Mier Cinema. You've certainly passed it on your way to the swimming pool. If you want to have fun on water slides, or indulge in proper swimming training and wellness, then we recommend visiting the **thermal Water park Senec** on Sunny Lakes, which is the closest of its kind to the Small Carpathians.



in a cornet and a mocha cup

Do you know why motorcyclists often make a short stop and car drivers deliberately exit the motorway to pass through **Modra**? Every tripper is happy to indulge in **Modra ice cream** without remorse. There are three ice cream parlours in the middle of Modra, whose owners are proud of the excellent recipes of this popular delicacy. Enjoy ice cream in the **Community Garden** opposite the Town Tower. It's a lovely place with trees, wooden benches and painted ceramic fairy tales on the walls. And you can peek beyond the town walls, the gate is open and is a shortcut to the world-famous service trees. We recommend that coffee lovers visit **Ebenica**, the Modra coffee-roasting plant. If they're closed for some reason, it's no problem, you can still buy quality coffee to take home or as a gift, or buy from a vending machine in front of the roasting plant. Wandering around the castles, you'll find the great **Častá Bakery**, which is open almost non-stop, and can be really useful with children.



at a feast with rich wines.

Feeding a bunch of kids during trips – one is sometimes challenging, but you can easily do this. Scroll through the booklet and choose from the restaurant tips throughout the Small Carpathians eastern foothills always in the penultimate column of the weekend or in the directory. There are plenty of them, you'll definitely agree on good meal together! The Small Carpathians region is well-known for its nature, ceramics and wine, so leaving it without a bottle of wine could be considered a crime! Many wineries and wine cellars are open on weekends. The young **wine association called Víno z Modry ('Wine from Modra')** connects high-quality Modra wineries where not only their wines can be tasted in the **500-years-old Pivnice U Pradedá** on the square. On the way to Harmónia, there is excellent winery **Vinárstvo Miroslava Duda** and delicious wines and sparkling wines can also be bought from the 'professor of wine' in the **Fedor Malík a syn (and Son)** family winery. The rich directory of Small Carpathian wine-makers and wineries are the for you, as well as plenty interesting information at www.malekarpaty.travel. Click!
