

Small Carpathian Museum in Pezinok

The Small Carpathian Museum is situated in the heart of Small Carpathians – in historical royal town of Pezinok. It is located in an authentic burgher's winemaking house from the 17th century. For more than 60 years, it has specialised on regional history and culture of viticulture and winemaking under Small Carpathians.

The museum presents the history of winemaking in the area of Small Carpathians, multimedia exhibitions and experience wine tasting. It opens a door to a trip to the history of our region that you can experience with all senses.

Tours are also available for visually disabled visitors – thanks to texts in Braille.

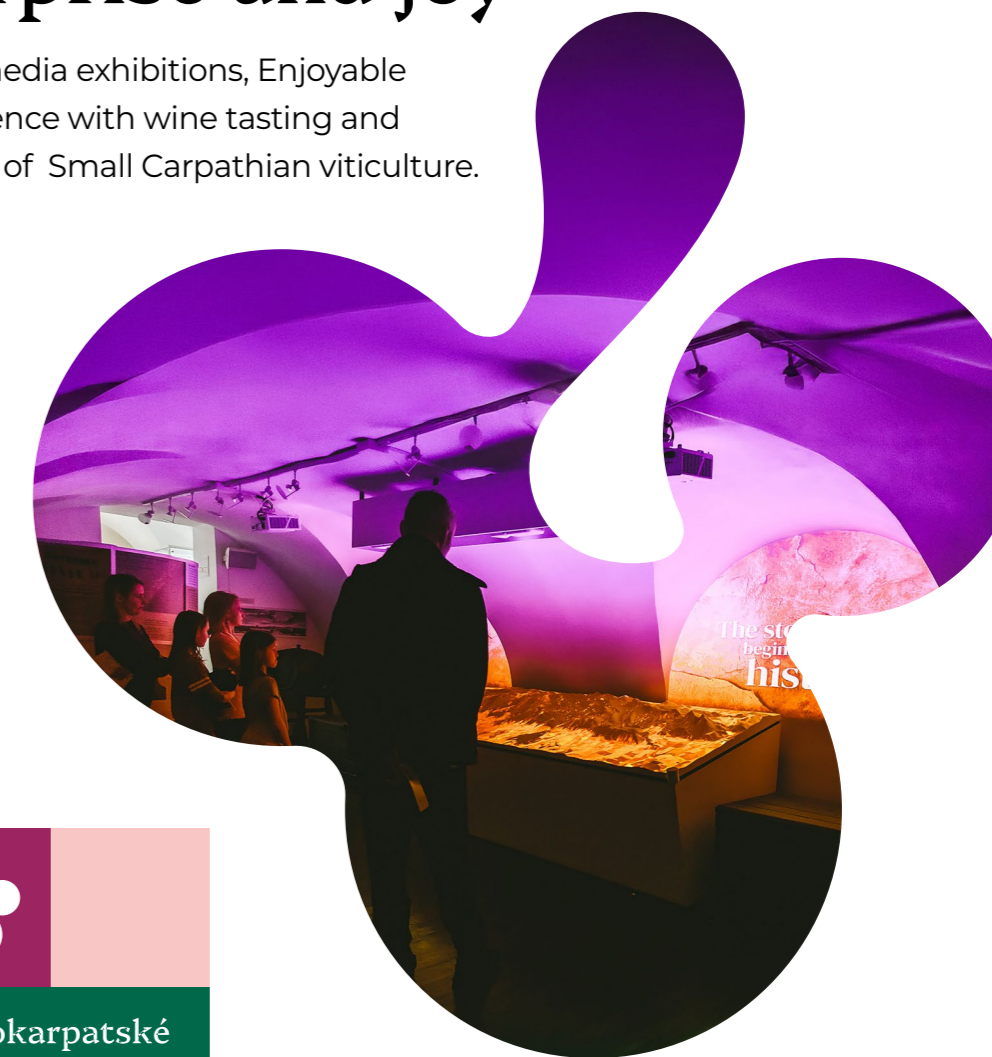

Interactive exhibitions

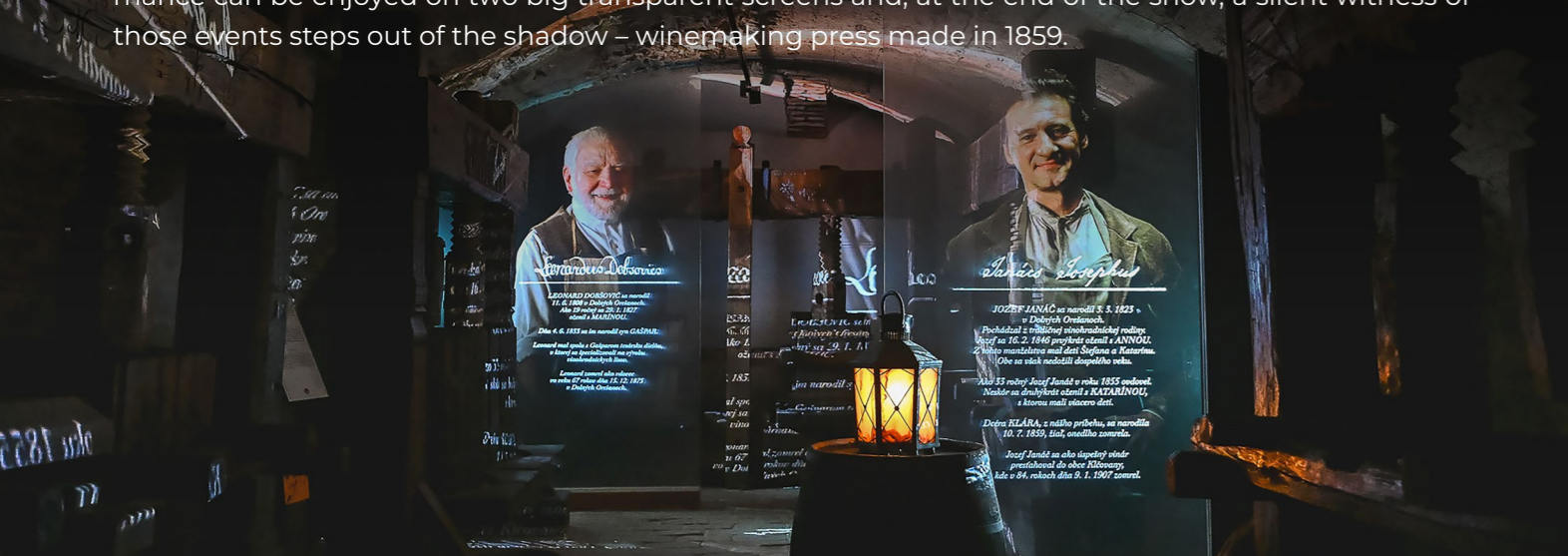
The story of wine in Small Carpathians

Our interactive exhibition will guide you through history of viticulture and winemaking in the Small Carpathians Wine Region – the most prominent wine region in Slovakia. Come and get to know typical wines of the region, learn about interesting archaeological findings as well as a rich collection of guild objects from Pezinok. In a couple of minutes, the multimedia presentation on relief 3D map will show you round the 2,000-year history of the region and winemaking in this territory in an attractive and innovative way. There are several entertaining features waiting for you during the tour: drunkenness simulator, interactive pillar, torture chamber and virtual reality that will take you back to history – to the Neštich castle in Svätý Jur at the time of Great Moravia.

History of viticulture and winemaking at the foot of Small Carpathians

The second permanent exhibition can be found in origin at renaissance cellars built in the 17th century. It features a unique and biggest collection of winemaking presses in Europe. The tour provides visitors with practical demonstration of winemaking activities – carving of a wooden winemaking wheel and stoppering of wine bottles. You can become a sommelier for a while too – and test your sense of smell by aromabar.

Our unique exhibition also features an attractive technology holography that will catch your breath. “Klára’s press – true story of tears, happiness and wine” is an emotional narrative of winemaker Jozef Janáč from Dolné Orešany, who managed to succeed, even despite bad fate, and find his happiness in life. The main character is masterfully presented by Slovak actor Marko Igonda. An impressive performance can be enjoyed on two big transparent screens and, at the end of the show, a silent witness of those events steps out of the shadow – winemaking press made in 1859.



Tasting wine with all senses

- unique concept of wine tasting, combination of art, music, colours and modern projections

Each tasting is accompanied with multimedia presentation called “The story of wine in Small Carpathians” and a tour in the cellar exhibition of the museum. Wine tasting also comes with small refreshment (pastry, sausage, two types of cheese and water).

Children in the museum

Museum exhibitions and displays let children enjoy narrative about the history of the region of Small Carpathians by means of attractive tasks and creative workshops for families with children. During the exhibition tour, our youngest visitors look for wooden chests with mascots from museum education programmes for children. So, together with Prešík and Prešinka, they work on assignment prepared for them.

The offer also includes educational programmes for school groups of various age categories.
